
Supplies Used: Stamp Set-D1374 Ms. Holiday Cheer, Paper-X7115B Jingle Level 2 Paper Packet, Markers-Blush, Juniper, Grème Brulee, White Daisy Ribbon, Archival Ink, Glitter Glitz.

## Directions:


- 1. Gut Gardstock base 4  $\frac{1}{4}$  x 11".
- 2, Score at 3", 5 1/2" and 8".



3. Fold in half. Then fold the ends in, towards the centerfold.



4. Apply Tombow Adhesive as shown. (On second folded piece in the shape of a G. Fold as shown below.



5. Gut layering Background and Texture Paper and adhere if desired. I gut goordinating pieces from our Level 2 (Jingle) Paper kit. I gut all sizes ¼" of an inch smaller than original piece. If you don't want to layer, you can random stamp your background.

IMPORTANT: If you want to add ribbon to your gift holder, do it on top of Background and Texture paper BEFORE you attach your top, focal layer. (in example-the girl image).



6. Use a circle punch and punch a half circle on the fold. Use an exacto knife to cut a slit to make a perfect size home for the gift card.





7. Finish decorating the inside. Insert a gift eard and share with someone special!
